

**Minutes of Humane Society of Northwest Georgia**  
**March 21, 2016**

28 people were in attendance.

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

Guest Speaker: Dr. Geena Davis, Dalton Animal Care North, who spoke about issues concerning aging pets.

Financial: Martha reported that our February revenue was \$10,070.75 and our income after expenses was \$4184.30.

Building: Alan Peeples stated that we have met the goal we set for the amount to be spent on the building, but we need to consider whether we can sustain the operation.

Adoptions: 19 Dogs adopted and 6 cats.

2 bales of straw  
6 styrofoam cat shelters

Maintenance: Marilyn Lance has pressure washed the inside kennels. Some of the concrete needs to be patched. We need to pressure wash the cage room. She has purchased a new sofa for the lobby and asks for our help in protecting it. Watch out for glass chips on the hill.

Susan thanked Elizabeth Leitch for the hard work on the Pancake Breakfast. We need to get an earlier start on this next year.

Miscellaneous: There was a discussion about the "Roman Open" golf tournament and whether we could be one of the charities helped with the money raised.

Susan suggested that we think about using some foster homes.
